> Physical Agility Test certificate from Cuyahoga Community College or eligible accredited agency
> Documentation for extra credit (see Extra Credits below)
> Check or money order for \$35 non-refundable processing fee payable to the City of Rocky River, Ohio (**cash is not acceptable**)
> Completed Police Division Entrance Exam Checklist
- Maximum: The first 200 fully completed applications submitted by March 6th will be accepted.

REQUIREMENTS

- Age: At least 21, but less than 35 on date of appointment with the City of Rocky River
- Citizenship: U.S. citizen, have legally declared intent to become U.S. citizen, or permanent resident
- Education: High School diploma or equivalent
- Licenses: Must have valid Driver's License
- Physical Agility: Physical Agility Test Certificate from Cuyahoga Community College completed no more than one year prior to March 6, 2020.

Based on the results of the Tri-C testing, the Civil Service Commission will establish an appropriate number of candidates, with a passing grade of 70% or better, to proceed in the selection process. Those candidates will be asked to complete the City of Rocky River Civil Service Application for Employment and submit documents for extra credit as listed below.

EXTRA CREDIT

<u>Credit</u>	<u>%</u>	<u>Documentation Required:</u>
Veteran (honorable discharge)	5%	Copy of DD214 with honorable discharge
College degree (4 yr/accruited) or	4%	Copy of diploma or official transcript
College degree (2 yr/accruited)	2%	Copy of diploma or official transcript
Paramedic Certification or	2%	Copy of current certificate
EMT Certification	1%	Copy of current certificate
Ohio Peace Officer Certificate	3%	Copy of current certificate

Appropriate documentation is required to receive the extra credit percent. The extra credit percentages will be applied to the written test scores to establish the final adjusted score.

The 15 candidates with the highest adjusted scores will proceed through additional testing at the discretion of the Civil Service Commission and the Police Chief. Additional testing may include interview, polygraph test, background investigation, psychological exam, and physical exam including drug screen. Applicants must pass all examinations to be considered for appointment.

The discovery of any knowingly false statement will be regarded as good cause for excluding the applicant from the examination, or for removing his/her name from any eligibility list, and may result in referral of the incident to law enforcement authorities.
